Who are BSAT?

They are an experienced and highly talented group of practitioners who work with children and young people aged 3-18, TAs, school support workers, teachers and senior leadership teams. They work to support inclusion in schools and settings in the area of personal and social development, behaviour for learning, SEMH and wellbeing. We support schools to improve learning for young people with SEND, social emotional and wellbeing needs.

What is FAP?

Fair Access Panel – FAP
(Headteachers and LA Officers).
Schools go to FAP for advice
and guidance in relation to
child's behaviour concerns and
can access learning mentors
and access to Linden Centre,
House 1 and student
engagement programme.

What is the Pre-suspension hotline?

This is a service offered to schools. Each student is entitled to 30 minutes support, free of charge, each term.

School complete a request to the service.

What is the Inclusive schools Forum?

A meeting of school professionals including head teachers and SENCos who have expertise in SEND.

This is also an opportunity for schools to network and gain guidance from each other about how to meet children's needs effectively, In addition schools can ask the Inclusive School Forum for funding to support children's complex SEND, this may include, but not limited to, support services, therapy, positive play and or teaching assistants to provide specific learning programmes.

Who are Strengthening Families?

They offer family support (0-19) at the family home on a one-to-one basis for targeted vulnerable families. Our Early Intervention Practitioners offer early help parenting strategies and whole family support by bringing together the right services around the family.

What is Alternative Provision?

AP is defined as 'education outside school, arranged by local authority or school themselves'
